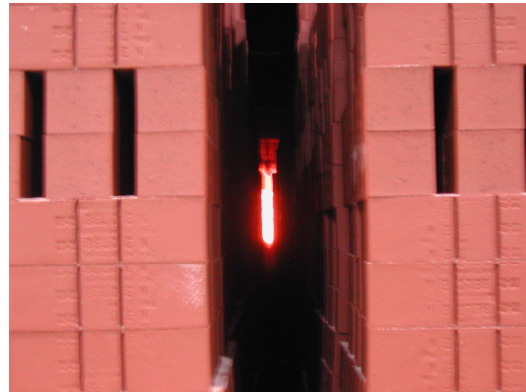


Tour of Glen-Gery Brick's Pittsburgh Plant

Join the CSI Pittsburgh Chapter on a tour of a working brick plant. Glen-Gery Brick, part of Brickworks, will give CSI members a guided tour through their facility in Cheswick (Harmar), PA. This plant produces face brick and pavers using the extrusion method. Find out how brick are made from the mining of the clay to its grinding, forming and the most important step, the firing in long kilns. The last time our chapter took this tour years ago, most attendees couldn't stop talking about how much they learned.
